The issue of Dual Citizenship has been raised by many individuals and organizations in United States of America for years. NRN's contributions to Nepal's economic development are vital; and NRN International Coordination Council (ICC) has been advocating for dual citizenship by lobbying with the Nepali leaders and law makers. It has been a top priority of NRN Association since its inception.

A task force of NRN ICC, led by Mr. Ram Thapa (Germany) is working closely with the 55 plus National Coordination Council and others. We all hope that the Government and the Constitution Assembly and its Constitution Drafting Committee of Nepal give serious considerations to the issue of dual citizenship and make appropriate provisions in the new constitution. NRNA believes that dual citizenship provisions is not important not just for us to maintain identity as Nepalis but that it will also benefit Nepal.

On behalf of our Board of Directors, we would like to revisit the issue of Dual Citizenship. We have requested **Mr. Khagendra Chhetry (New York)** to lead the **task force on Dual Citizenship** and **submit a recommendation to the NCC President by April 10, 2010**. Last year, on April 1, 2009, NRN NCC of USA submitted a recommendation by the task force led by Mr. Chhetry as attached.
