Terms of reference: NRNA Constitution, Proposed Amendment Draft and NCC USA's Suggestions.

Previous meeting minute: The previous minute was taken as read.

Roll called: General Secretary.

Meeting Open: Senior Vice-President/ Acting President with opening remarks.

Agendas:

1. Proposed Amendment draft of NRNA Constitution and NCC USA's Suggestions in it.
2. Unpaid dues of Mr. Ram C Kharel owed.

• **Special Note:**

Before the meeting was formally opened, Mr. Sanjay Thapa, BOD, raised questions regarding the "NRN Citizenship Memorandum" submission event to the Nepal Government through the Nepali General Consulate, NY, USA. He asked the acting president, who was the chair of the meeting as well; I was thinking about the memorandum going to submission under the leadership of NRNA NCC, USA. However, what we have seen was not that. There are some other organizations listed on the memorandum whose representatives signed the document as well. How come those who are not authorized signatories of NRNA NCC USA have signed the document that is prepared on NRNA NCC USA's letterhead? The acting president then answered, as we are raising the common issues of NRN, that we should get support from the

other organizations. These things were not hiding from the board or the public. The general secretary has posted it on the Google group, and it was published on the NRNA NCC USA's Facebook page as well. We have listed the names of the organizations that are going to be involved in the event and requested that other organizations join us as well. Since everything is transparent and everyone is aware of it, this question should not be raised. Furthermore, Acting President requested the general secretary to answer the questions about signatories and the rest. The General Secretary said, "I thank Mr. Sanjay Thapa for taking concern about the Organization; we should take this as positive. I would request you to see the document (memorandum) once again. There are the signatures from the various organizations right behind the name of their respective organization's name. Moreover, those signatures are above the closing. In the closing, the General Secretary, NRNA, NCC, USA have signed. I would request all to please understand the general trends. The general trend is that any organization who is helping [involved] in the event can sign on the main organizer's letterhead, but the closing sign must be from the host organization." The General Secretary then claimed the meeting was not formally opened yet and that we should move forward formally. The General Secretary then asked the Senior Vice President for his opening remarks.

- **Opening Remark by Chair of the meeting:**

The chair of the meeting, the senior vice-president/acting president, in his opening remarks, explained that the meeting was called on the request of the NRNA to have a discussion and provide needed suggestions to the NRNA regarding the proposed amendment draft of the NRNA constitution. Furthermore, he informed the board of the second agenda item, "Unpaid dues of Mr. Ram C Kharel." Explaining the second agenda item, the chair stated, "As we are all aware that Mr. Ram C Kharel had claimed his unpaid dues, and it was declined in NRNA NCC USA's 4th board meeting due to lack of sufficient proof that can prove he owed it. Now, the situation is different. Mr. Kharel has authorized an attorney to [initiate a] lawsuit, and the attorney electronically reached [out] to us. After we received the email form Mr. Kharel's attorney, we contacted to the immediate officials (President, Senior Vice-President, and Treasurer), and they clarify that the debt owed to Mr. Kharel (**the electronic communication between the general secretary and immediate officials of NRNA NCC USA is attached herewith at Annex I**). So, [we] will make a decision on it as well. Now, I authorize to the general secretary to move forward the meeting."

After the opening remarks, the general secretary wanted to move the agenda forward, but Sanjay Thapa, BOD, interrupted, citing, the meeting cannot move forward without complete discussion on the question that he has raised. Then, some of the participants shared their thoughts on the question. Sharing his thoughts, Mr. Jedu Pokharel, Regional Vice President,

asked how the general secretary became a co-coordinator of the CNC Lobbyist Committee. Mr. Pokharel then accused the general secretary of selfishness, "putting himself in the center." Answering Mr. Pokharel's question, the general secretary then cited that the previous meeting had given him the authority to become a co-coordinator, and he pointed out the decision of the previous meeting whereby "the committee will be form[ed] [by the] lead effort of [the] general secretary" was mentioned. The general secretary then announced that he is not a selfish person nor self-centered, so he withdrew his name from the committee.

• Discussion & Decision

1. Proposed Amendment draft of NRNA Constitution and NCC USA's Suggestions in it.

On the authority of the chair, the general secretary opened the floor for discussion. Opening the floor, the general secretary then said, "As the secretariat had already forwarded the 'Draft Constitution' to the board for needy perusal, we believe that the board is aware of it." He then asked the board if it needed to be read. The board members requested to the general secretary to read it, and the general secretary then shared the screen and read it (The proposed amendment draft of NRNA Constitution is attached herewith at Annex II). After reading the "Proposed Amendment Draft of NRNA Constitution", the floor was opened up for discussion.

Taking part in the discussion, all of the participants cited that all nine of the models that NRNA proposed is unacceptable, and the participants suggested forming a committee to work on it. The general secretary requested the Acting President to conclude the agenda. Concluding the agenda, the chair of the meeting (Senior Vice-President/Acting President) noted that based on the discussion, we should go through the committee to prepare our suggestions, but as we already have a "Bylaws Committee", we do not need to form a new committee; rather, we would give authority to the "Bylaws Committee". The general secretary then asked the board whether it was accepted. The board accepted it and it passed unanimously.


2. Unpaid dues of Mr. Ram C Kharel owed.

Please be advised that the undersigned represents the interests of Ram C. Kharel, who has been copied on this email.

I am writing to you in your official capacity as the President of NRNA, NCC USA.

On August 22, 2014, NRNA, NCC USA hosted a fundraising event at the Waterford Receptions, LLC at Springfield, Virginia. Mr. Lok Nath Tiwari, then Vice-President of your organization asked Mr. Kharel to pay the cost of the event and promised that NRNA, NCC USA will reimburse him for the payment. In reliance upon this representation, Mr. Kharel paid \$3341.42. After repeated requests for reimbursement over the past four years, Mr. Kharel has not been paid the amount duly owed to him by NRNA, NCC USA.

Please accept this electronic communication as final demand for payment. Mr. Kharel has authorized my firm to initiate lawsuit if payment is not received by him within twenty days of this communication.

You are on notice that if we initiate legal proceedings, we will see the cost of the suit, attorney fees and interest as allowed under the law.

Mr. Ram C. Kharel has claimed the sum of \$3341.42 to NRNA NCC USA, citing it was due from August 22, 2014. We haven't found any official document that proves this debt is owed. Because of that reason, the Current Board declined his claim at its 4th Meeting. Now, Mr. Fitzgerald Lewis, an attorney on his behalf, wrote us the below email with a 20-days deadline (please review the email). We kindly request you clarify, with details, whether the amount that Mr. Kharel claimed needs to be paid. Thanking you.

As you all know, back in 2014-2015 we had successfully organized the fundraising program for the ICC building on the presence of Former NRNA ICC president MR.Shesh Ghale. I was a treasurer at that time, and had designated the local board member from the region to coordinate the fundraising dinner. Mr. Lok Tiwari former Sr VP and former youth coordinator Barsha Moktan were organizing for the DC metro area, from where this issue came up.

Once the donation program was ended, I as a treasurer collected all the donation in one separate account (ICC BUILDING FUND) at BANK of America, later we got several followup from the NRNA ICC to transfer the available fund to Nepal, and we did transfer the collected fund to NRNA.

After a month or so (not sure on date) MR Kharel contacted me and asked me about the outstanding invoice which I was not aware of, later, Lok Jee, Ram jee and me had a conference and got the confirmation about the dues Mr Kharel claimed was legitimate. And by that time, we had already transfer the fund to Nepal and there was only 800-900 dollar on that ICC BUILDING fund. Since, all the donors lived on DC Metro area I requested Lok jee and Ram jee to follow up with the people who had committed the amount, so we can deposit and pay off to Mr. Kharel but unfortunately it didn't happen.

Since, he send us the invoice late but still we owe him his legitimate outstanding amount.
